About Stillwater Music

Stillwater Music is Durango's premier music education hub offering unique, high-quality ensemble and band opportunities, private music lessons, in-school music classes, and inclusive music/dance classes. Stillwater Music is a nonprofit organization that serves over 700 students of all ages annually helping them develop their individual musical abilities for lifelong personal and community benefits.

At Stillwater, we use two very different yet complementary tracks for music instruction: (1) traditional private lessons on almost any musical instrument as well as voice lessons, and (2) the less traditional but very fun "play in a real band" approach to learning music. We also host classes of elementary and middle school children from area schools in our facility every week and serve as the only music instruction program for those schools.

Stillwater Music has grown exponentially in the past few years. We've expanded from a staff of two providing music instruction in a converted car wash, to a booming organization with 6 staff members and 30 contractors providing quality music education in our 6,500+ square foot facility in downtown Durango. Our staff consists of an Executive Director, a Program Director, two full time Music Instructors, a Registrar & Event Coordinator, and a Private Lesson Coordinator. Our private lessons and bands are taught by professional, real world working musicians with years of experience teaching music, directing bands, coaching, recording, performing, arranging and writing music. The work environment is casual, collegial, and relaxed.

The Stillwater mission is to share the joy of playing music by developing in our students the skills, confidence, and ability to play music. We feel strongly that keeping kids engaged in music helps to build character, teamwork and self confidence. The repertoire for most of our bands is focused on popular music from the 50's through today--rock, funk, pop, jazz, hip hop, R&B, blues, soul, bluegrass, folk...it's what's on your playlist. Stillwater bands can be found performing in various venues around southwestern Colorado from upscale fundraising events, to outdoor festivals and community events, to restaurants or the quaint patio of a coffee shop, to private house parties.

About this Position

Pending a successful interview, the Candidate will co-teach with one of our full-time instructors for one term. This is an unpaid intern position (past interns have received credit hours for teaching). Candidate must be committed to entire term and end of term performance(s) with limited absences. Candidates should be working toward a degree in Music Education, Music Performance or General Music.

We are looking for someone who is excited about the growth opportunities in our organization, who is a well-rounded multi-instrumentalist and is passionate about working with kids.

We provide music classes for several local elementary and middle schools in Durango. These programs vary between the schools. Some utilize a more traditional music instructional approach, including teaching singing, ukulele, Orff and/or percussion/drumming classes. With others, we primarily utilize our band model.

In our unique band program, kids learn instrumental technique on guitar, drum kit, hand percussion, vibraphone, marimba, keyboard, ukulele, steel pan, and electric bass and other instruments, as well as singing. Stillwater band classes are conducted in teaching studios that are fully equipped with drum sets, percussion, guitars, electric basses, mallet instruments, electronic keyboards, instrument amps and PA systems.

Our Instructors are expected to teach “just enough, just in time” applied music theory, ear training, music literacy, soloing, comping, harmonizing, arranging and the basics of musical professionalism in the context of preparing tunes for performance.

Responsibilities:

- Co-teach music classes using various instrumentation, such as ukulele, Orff instruments, and/or percussion, as well as singing
- Co-teach band classes using the Stillwater “be in a band” model to teaching music
- Assist in arranging/choosing repertoire that is appropriate for the age and ability level of students
- Utilize a variety of musical genres to teach music concepts
- Help prepare students for performances
- Participate in weekly staff meetings

Skills and Desired Characteristics:

- Proficiency on multiple instruments preferred
- Musical literacy using standard music notation
- Working knowledge of music notation software such as Finale is a plus
- Knowledge of sound equipment
- Candidate is working toward a degree in Music Education, Music Performance or General Music
